Deansfield House

On the outskirts of the historic village of Brewwood, Deansfield House is within walking distance of the village centre and its facilities. Wolverhampton and Stafford are easily accessible and there are good links to the M54 and M6.

Deansfield House has 19 one-bedroomed apartments, offering secure, comfortable and affordable accommodation including a secure CCTV door entry system, residents' lounge and kitchen, guest bedroom (a charge applies), communal laundry and a lift to all floors.

- Kitchen with fitted units, large built-in storage cupboard, alarm cord and space for an oven and fridge
